CHORAL READING GUIDELINES

1. Assemble students using teacher discretion.
2. Students must speak words clearly.
3. Speak as one voice.
4. Pause only for punctuation or dramatic emphasis.
5. Stand tall, no moving around, keep feet together, hands still.
6. This poem has a serious setting (if you use a humorous setting, hand and/or facial actions may be used).
7. Have the poem copy in hands, you may choose to mount copies on colored construction paper and you may choose to memorize the poem.
