



ELLIS ISLAND: DREAM OF AMERICA

Math Lesson, Post Performance Activity
Grade Level: 4

OBJECTIVES

After reading the book, *Liberty*, and attending the symphony concert at the Globe-News Center for the Performing Arts, students will complete the problem-solving examples focused on the symphony performance and the provided reading material.

MATERIALS

Book about Statue of Liberty: *Liberty* by Dona R. McDuff
Math worksheet entitled *Do the Math*

PREPARATION

Students read and discussed *Liberty* before attending the symphony performance and will use the book as a reference to answer math questions in this lesson.

PROCEDURE

Students are instructed to solve problems with information given in the examples and refer to the book, *Liberty*, for information to solve problems related to the statue.

EVALUATION

Grade test and discuss problems.

PRACTICE

Have students write a story-problem that deals with measurement of the Statue of Liberty.
